Secretary Report:

- Kayla suggested posting updated By-Laws, meeting Minutes, Rainout Policy, and Rules on the GSA website. All were in favor

Treasurer's Report:

- \$37,000 total for 2024-2025 Season
- About \$65,000 balance in checking

Outstanding Business

- Signs- Discussed ordering mesh signs for the back of dugouts as multi-year sponsors
- The fence on Field 5 was finished. Kyla will make a Facebook post thanking Mallard and letting people know it was done.
- Mallard quoted a warm-up area for the softball pitchers at \$4,500

Circuit for out-of-town teams:

- Discussed putting together a separate league for travel teams. The league would give the opportunity for out-of-town teams to play, but not against our rec teams.

Final rules for baseball and softball

- 14U Softball will stay in town to play. If there are 2 teams, they will play each other. If there is only one, they will merge with 12U.
- 14U baseball will travel to Perrin, Graford, and Bryson at the least
 - 14U softball rules will stay the same as the previous year
 - 12U softball rules will stay the same as the previous year, including the look-back rule and stealing when the ball crosses the plate
 - 10U softball will be tabled until the next meeting, 02/02/2026
 - 8U softball will stay the same as the previous year
 - 6U Softball will be competitive Tball with no coach pitch. Brian made a motion, Chris second and all were in favor.
 - 14U baseball will stay the same as the previous year
 - 12U baseball will move to 70' bases and allow lead-offs. 3rd drop will go into effect halfway through the season. All other rules will remain the same as the previous season. Nate made a motion, Kyla Second and all were in favor
 - 10U baseball will stay the same as the previous year.
 - 8U baseball will stay the same as the previous year.
 - 6U baseball if they hit off a tee ALL players will be allowed to move one base. All other rules will remain the same as previous year
 - For the tournament, all age groups will have 6 run limits except for 12U baseball, which will be unlimited.

Early Spring Tournament:

- March 28th and June 13th will be the dates for baseball tournaments in 2026
 - Kayla will create a Google Form for sign-ups
 - Chris will contact STS to get it posted on their website
 - Kayla will post rain out for rings on the GSA site
 - No refunds after schedules have been made
 - Kayla will modify STS rules and times for the tournament and post on GSA
